2023 Lititz Borough Garbage Collection Information

Collection days in Lititz Borough are Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, depending on where you live. Trash/Recycles should be placed out at the curb the night **before** your collection day, as the hauler does start very early in the morning. Contact the Borough office if you do not know your collection day. Three 32-gallon trash cans or bags may be set out per week per household. Extra trash may be put out but must be marked with an extra service tag according to the following guidelines:

Yellow tag	\$1.50	For disposal of extra bags/cans of regular household trash	
Blue tag	\$3.00	For the disposal of tires. *Tires are picked up only twice yearly during the months of April and October. (Apr 12-14 and Oct 11-13)	
Red tag	\$4.00	For disposal of large items such as: mattress, box spring, grill, sofa, furniture, bicycle etc. (NO MORE THAN 2 RED TAG ITEMS PER WEEK)	
Gold	\$12.00	For disposal of large appliances such as: washer, dryer, A/C, refrigerator, dishwasher, stove, water heater, dehumidifier etc. * Appliances are picked up ONLY twice yearly during the months of April and October. (Apr 12-14 and Oct 11-13)	
Kraft bags (available at the Borough office)	\$1.00	For disposal of yard waste, including leaves, garden residue, and shrubbery (no dirt, grass clippings or acorns). Such trash will be collected bi-monthly from April through Nov (dates below) and must be bundled or placed in the biodegradable Kraft bags. Bundles should be no larger than 4 feet in length, 6 inches in diameter, and 30lbs, and must be tied with biodegradable twine. The bags/bundles are delivered to a compost facility.	

Kraft Bag Collection dates

Kraft bags will be collected bi-monthly on the same day as your regular trash, but will be picked up *SEPARATELY*. <u>Yard waste cannot be mixed with household trash during the Kraft bag collection months</u>. Following are the collection dates:

April – weeks of the 10 th & 24 th	July – weeks of the 10th & 24th	Oct – weeks of the 9th & 23rd
May – weeks of the 8th & 22rd	August – weeks of the 7th & 21st	Nov – weeks of the 6th & 20th
June – weeks of the 12th & 26th	Sept – weeks of the 11th & 25th	

Recycling

Recyclable materials are collected weekly on the same day as trash. Recyclable materials include: Aluminum and steel cans, clear, green or brown glass bottles and jars, plastics (bottles, jars and jugs only), and flattened corrugated cardboard. Recycling bins are available at the Borough Office at no charge (one per household).

Curbside Leaf Collection

Lititz Borough does weekly curbside leaf collection, weather permitting, from approximately mid-October through early December. Dates and regulations will be advertised in the Lititz Record and on the Borough's website in early October. Leaves will <u>only</u> be collected at curbside during these designated times.

Holiday Collection Schedule

Lebanon Farms Disposal observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls ON OR BEFORE your regular collection day, your trash will be delayed by one day for that week only. Saturday and Sunday holidays DO NOT affect collection days. The following collection schedule will apply for 2023:

Weeks of Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, and Christmas Day: <u>All collection</u> will be delayed by one day. Week of Thanksgiving: <u>Thursday and Friday customers only</u> will be delayed by one day. Weeks of New Year's Day 2023 are NOT affected this year.

Household Hazardous Waste

Items such as *paints, gasoline, cleansers, auto products, batteries, computers (including keyboards, mouse, printers and speakers), televisions and cell phones CANNOT be set out with regular trash,* but can be disposed of free of charge at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility located at 1299 Harrisburg Pike, Lancaster.
